



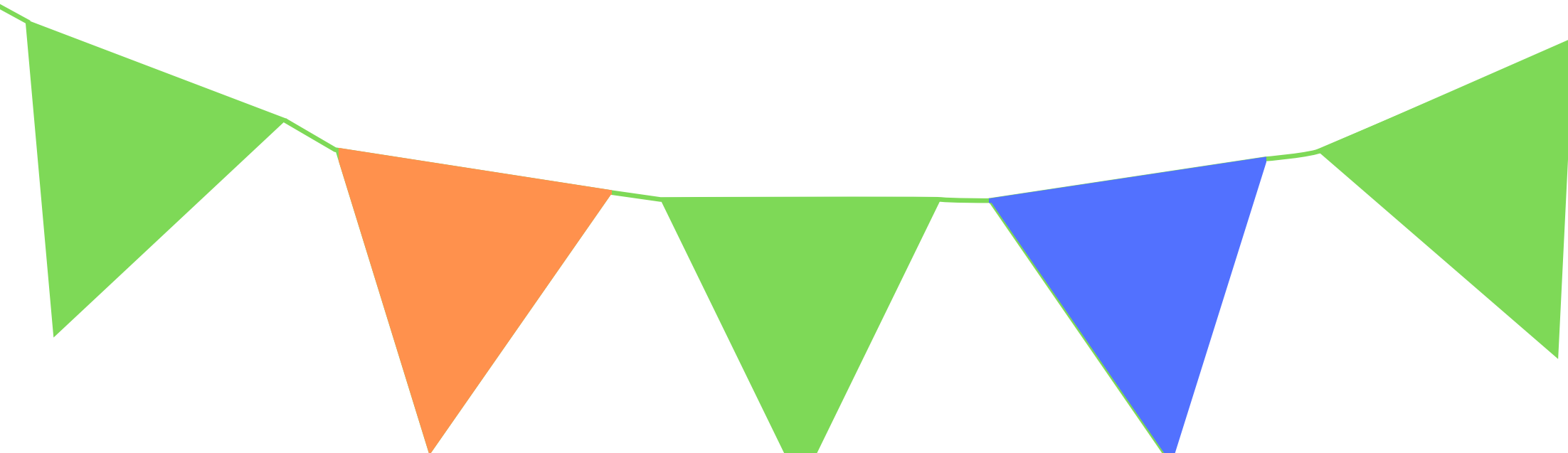
# STATEMENT OF FAITH
